Call for Nominations

The Sri Lanka Association of Printers is pleased to announce the presentation of the **Lifetime Achievement Awards at the Sri Lanka Print 2018 Biennial Print Award Ceremony** to be held on Sunday 18th March from 6.30 PM at Shangri-La Hotel, Colombo.

Sri Lanka Association of Printers' Lifetime Achievement Award is the highest honor that the Association bestows on its members who have been rendering their volunteer services to the industry. Selection for this honor recognizes an individual's outstanding and sustained contributions both to their profession and to the Industry. It recognizes individuals who have gone far beyond the standard obligation to become a significant force in shaping the printing industry of Sri Lanka.

The Lifetime Achievement Award will be made to a maximum of two distinguished persons living or posthumously at each Award Ceremony.

Nominating an individual provides an opportunity to honor someone you believe, who has made a major long-term contribution to, and has had a significant impact on the print industry. The presentation of the Lifetime Achievement Awards will be the most important item culminating the Awards Ceremony.

Members of the Sri Lanka Association of Printers can propose names by completing the nomination form which is attached hereto. The guidelines from page 2 to 3 contain among other matters, the selection criteria, nomination and selection process.

To nominate a person, please read the instructions carefully.

1. Nominations for the "Lifetime Achievement Award" must use the Nomination Form attached hereto or a facsimile copy of the same.
2. Answer all question as fully, clearly and concisely as possible.
3. Provide not more than three pages of narrative support of achievements and the resume of the nominee.
4. Additional information may be provided in support of achievements.

PURPOSE

The Lifetime Achievement Award recognizes personalities, living or posthumously, who have distinguished themselves by their contributions to the material communications industry that covers the full scope of Printing and Packaging, advertising, publishing, designing and producing print material, over a significant period.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The nominees for the Lifetime Achievement Award by SLAP should have demonstrated lifelong commitment to industry related activities and have contributed outstanding service as outlined below with exceptional personal integrity. Specific requirements to be considered in evaluating nominees include the following:

1. Contributions to Print Media Industry and other Material Communication related Industries

- Leadership that has influenced standards and professional practice
- Programs conducted or initiated and creativity in activities

2. Contributions to researches and surveys

- Performance in initiating, conducting and leading a project

3. Active and productive contributor on volunteer basis in uplifting the industry standards

- Setting quality standards and educating the industry
- Encouraging the industry stakeholders in uplifting the quality standards by organizing events

4. Contributions in Training and education

- Academic and Professional Qualifications in the Material Communication Industry
- Substantial experience in Material Communication Industry
- Invited teacher / lecturer
- Innovation in educational process

5. Special contributions to the field

- Contributions that elevate the national and international stature of the industry
- Obtaining Regulatory and state support to the industry
- Obtaining International Grants or support to the industry
- Pioneering technique or concept
- Device development
- Process innovation
- Patents
- Any other advancements

6. Publications

- Working on publications which impacts on the Industry
- Member - editorial board of Industry Publications
- Contributions of articles to publications

7. Other honors and recognitions received by the nominee or the representing company

8. Nominees should have a minimum of 25 years of distinguished service in the industry and the age should be over 55 years.

SELECTION PROCESS

Any SLAP member in good standing could nominate one person for the Award at each occasion.

Nominations will be reviewed by the Selection Committee appointed by the Sri Lanka Association of Printers, who will determine the recipients of Awards. Up to two Awards could be awarded at each Awards Ceremony. This year the nomination submission deadline shall be 5th March 2018 and the presentation of Awards will take place at the Sri Lanka Print Award Ceremony to be held on Sunday 18th March 2018 at Shangri-La, Colombo.

Nomination Letter and Supporting Material

Each nomination should be supported by a written account of eligibility for the Award with details of specific areas of achievement by the nominee and his/her resume. The nominations must be typewritten or printed, double-spaced and single-sided, with margins of at least one inch on A4 paper. Font size must be not smaller than 12-point. Five copies (one original and four copies) of the nomination forms set should be enclosed in a single envelope addressed to the Committee Chairman, SLAP Lifetime Achievement Award, Sri Lanka Association of Printers.

Nominations will be kept on file and reconsidered each year for five years. Nomination materials may be, but need not be, updated annually. Nominations may be withdrawn by nominators at any time.
